NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in accordance with the provisions of the Elections Laws of the State of California, that on March 3, 2020, there will be a Presidential Primary Election.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that official nomination petitions and declarations of candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for the offices listed above are available beginning November 12, 2019, from the Humboldt County Office of Elections at 2426 6th Street, Eureka, CA 95501, Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding holidays. Candidates may obtain more information by calling Humboldt County Office of Elections at 707-445-7481.

The declaration of candidacy must be filed by 5:00 p.m. December 6, 2019, at the Office of Elections. Declarations of candidacy will not be accepted after 5:00 p.m. on December 6, 2019,

unless the incumbent does not file. In the event that the incumbent does not file, the filing deadline is extended five days to 5:00 p.m. December 11, 2019, for anyone other than the incumbent. This extension does not apply to judicial candidates, as they must file declarations of intention earlier and the extension applies at that time.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, per Elections Code § 15104, that the verifying of signatures on vote-by-mail ballots cast for the Presidential Primary Election will commence on February 3, 2020, or at any time thereafter in the Humboldt County Office of Elections. On February 18, 2020, or at any time thereafter, the opening and processing of vote-by-mail ballots will commence. This process will continue until all election results are tabulated and the election is certified. Any member of the Humboldt County Grand Jury, and any other interested organization, shall be permitted to observe and challenge the manner in which the vote-by-mail ballots are handled, from the processing of ballot return envelopes through the opening, counting and disposition of the ballots. To register as an observer, please contact the Humboldt County Office of Elections at 707-445-7481.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the Presidential Primary Election, voted ballots will be counted on precinct-based counters and at central count at the Office of Elections. All results will be tallied at the Humboldt County Office of Elections, 2426 6th Street, Eureka, after the close of polls on Election Day.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the canvass will commence at 9:00 a.m. on March 5, 2020, at the Humboldt County Office of Elections. The Office of Elections will begin a manual tally of one percent of the precincts casting ballots at the March 3, 2020, Presidential Primary Election. This manual tally is open to the public and shall continue daily (Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays excluded unless otherwise decided by the County Registrar of Voters) until completed.
