**Charter Amendment Text Language**

Article II "ELECTIONS" of the Charter of the City of Eureka is amended at Section 202 to read:

**Section 202. ~~DATES OF PRIMARY AND GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.~~** For filling the elective office of Mayor and five (5) Council Members, a general municipal election ~~shall~~ must be held on the same date as the State of California general election and consolidated therewith. Municipal measures may also be submitted at said general election, as well as at special elections called for the purpose. As determined by the ranked choice voting process detailed in the ordinance the Council must enact under Section 207, the officers elected ~~shall be~~ are those who receive the majority of votes for each office at said general municipal election.

Article II "ELECTIONS" of the Charter of the City of Eureka is amended at Section 207 to read:

**SECTION 207. ~~PROCEDURE FOR HOLDING~~ CONDUCTING ELECTIONS.** ~~Unless otherwise provided by ordinance, all municipal elections shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California, as the same now exist or may hereafter be amended or superseded, for the holding of elections in general law cities, insofar as the same are not in conflict with this Charter. The Council by ordinance must provide for conducting municipal elections. In the elections of the Mayor and Council Member, the Council must provide for Ranked Choice Voting. Except as provided by this Charter or the Election Ordinance, the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California pertaining to municipal elections, as amended from time to time, govern.~~
